**PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

The Summer Intensive English Program for IBEAR MBA Students is designed to promote the linguistic and cultural acclimation of participants before they begin their university program. Students attend the language session for **six weeks** before the start of IBEAR MBA classes.

Program highlights include:

- > 23 hours of active English learning each week
- > Courses taught by USC International Academy faculty, all holding advanced degrees in the Teaching of English, Linguistics, or a related field
- > Dynamic, international student-centered classrooms with multicultural communication opportunities
- > Communicative approach with emphasis on both accuracy and fluency in English to prepare students for the rigorous IBEAR curriculum

All program participants attend daily; the following three classes are offered:

**1. Integrated Business English Skills (10 instructional hours per week)**

In this course, students develop their ability to use English effectively to complete academic reading and writing assignments typically found in graduate-level business courses. Students will learn how to approach college reading, listening and writing tasks while successfully communicating critical thinking. Classwork will involve analyzing case studies, identifying relevant research sources, and responding to critical questions about course content.

**2. Oral Skills (10 instructional hours per week)**

This course helps students develop interpersonal communication, public speaking, and pronunciation skills that are necessary for participating in graduate-level courses. Class assignments and discussions on topics related to cross-cultural communication will require critical thinking and will provide opportunities for extended speaking practice.

**3. American Culture (3 instructional hours per week)**

This course is designed for students to learn more about American culture as they prepare to live in Los Angeles. The course will cover topics related to American values, behavioral expectations, and life in LA.

Classes are held every day, Monday through Friday. The exact schedule and time of classes will be distributed following Orientation.

> **Bank Statement or Sponsorship Letter**

Students who need a Form I-20 must provide proof of financial support, including living expenses, for the entire duration of their studies. Please submit a personal bank statement showing an available balance of **\$7,937 USD (plus \$2,376 USD for your spouse and \$1,188 USD per child if applicable)**. If the bank account holder is under the name of a parent, guardian, or other personal sponsor, a *Letter of Support* must be submitted along with the bank statement. If a government or organization will provide funding, a signed Sponsorship Letter is required.

> **Passport copy**

Make a clear, readable copy of your passport page showing your name, date of birth, passport expiration date, and photograph. If your spouse (husband or wife) and/or children will come with you on an F-2 visa, please also include a clear copy of your spouse's/dependents' passport page(s).
