Application Requirements

- ✓ A completed online application
 - Create your profile by clicking the "Create Account" box.
 - Complete the four sections of the application
 (1. Personal Information 2. Academic History 3. Supporting Information 4. Program Materials)
- ✓ Four-year undergraduate degree, or equivalent
 - Applicants in the process of finishing an undergraduate degree may apply, with acceptance contingent on successful completion of the degree.
- ✓ Official academic transcripts from the Registrar of the institution where courses were taken
 - You must submit records of all post-secondary educational institutions that you attended. Please list all colleges and universities you have attended (including any community college, study abroad term, summer enrollment or ESL studies), in chronological order, starting with the first institution after high school graduation.
 - Cannot find your institution? Select: "Can't find your school?"
 For students who completed their degrees outside the U.S.,
 please check the "Country Requirements" section of the USC

- ✓ Essay answering the question: How will this degree help you to achieve your professional goals?
 - Upload a Word document or PDF of your personal statement essay.
 - Essays should be a maximum of 300 words.

✓ One letter of recommendation

- Provide the name and contact information for your recommender. After you complete and save this
- section, an email request will be sent to the recommender on your behalf.
- Recommender must submit letter online by the application deadline.
- Letters of recommendation may be provided by a professor, direct supervisor, or equivalent.
- Letters should describe specific observations and examples of your leadership, teamwork, analytical skills, and personal qualities that make you a great candidate for the MSSE program.
- Letters must be received in order for the application to be considered complete.
- ✓ Online interview: Information will be sent to you via email after the submission of the online application.
 - You will be asked to complete the online interview within one week of submitting the online application.
- **✓** English Language Proficiency Requirements TOEFL/IELTS (if applicable)
- **√** Application fee: \$155
