# **Frequently Asked Questions**

### **Roundtable Rotation Networking Events**

### What is a Roundtable event?

• Pre-assigned small student groups will rotate every twenty minutes, meeting employer representatives at assigned table(s). Rotation assignments are based on student preferred interest in the roles offered by your organization. The reception at the conclusion provides an opportunity to meet students not assigned during the formal rotations.

### What are the benefits to my organization?

Roundtables provide your organization the ability to generate student interest, making earliest possible connections in the
recruiting season. Students will be assigned to your table rotations based on their expressed interest in the roles offered
by your firm. You will receive the rotation assignment list along with the student resumes prior to the event.
The interactive format enables employers to attract, engage and expedite continued recruiting efforts with selected
candidates. You may have more than one company representative attend and host additional tables.

### What do I need to provide to participate?

• It is helpful for students to know the roles (function descriptions, location, internship or full time) your firm may be interested in recruiting and posted in 12Twenty. This information will be used by the students when they bid on preferred table rotation assignments.

### What is the time commitment?

• Approximately 3-4 hours per event. A detailed schedule will be provided at the time of registration confirmation.

### What is the cost?

- Registration is free. We provide complimentary parking, meals/refreshments to all guest attendees.
- Within 24-48 hours of your registration, you will receive confirmation and calendar invitation.

### **Meet-the-Firms Events**

### What is a Meet-the-Firm event?

• The event will be open networking with high-top tables for a more relaxed "walk-around" networking style providing ample opportunity to mix and mingle with students to learn more about internship and full-time opportunities.

### What is the time commitment?

Approximately 2-3 hours per event. You may have more than one company representative attend/host additional tables.

### What do I need to provide to participate?

• It is helpful for students to know the roles (function descriptions, location, internship or full time) your firm may be interested in recruiting and posted in 12Twenty.

### What is the cost?

• Registration is free. We provide complimentary parking, meals/refreshments to all guest attendees.

### **Multi-Employer Virtual Talent Connections**

### What is a virtual Talent Connections?

• This virtual event will give you the opportunity to meet students through one-on-one "coffee-chat style" sessions. You can choose the graduate program to target your recruiting; MBA, Masters or both. There is no cost to participate.

### Do students pre-register for each session?

• Company schedules will be available to students to select specific session times based on employer preference to meet students one-on-one for 15 or 20 minute timed sessions.

### Can you help with setting up our schedule?

• We work with each firm to set-up the "coffee-chat" schedules based on the number of "rooms" you wish to host.

### How can Graduate Career Services assist the most successful outcome?

• We can post your job descriptions, updated company profile information, additional company resources to 12Twenty for broad student visibility. Your relationship manager can further assist you in scheduling additional programming, too.
